- Deal with all correspondence received via e-mail, telephone or post
- Liaise with the 3 Land Tenants with the Town Estate and produce timely invoices for all rents due
- Liaise with Almspeople and their relatives/friends regarding their residency of the Almshouses
- Manage orders to suppliers and payments via online banking.
- Inspect the Almshouses regularly and deal with any maintenance issues, in liaison with the Trustees if necessary.
- Arrange all Annual and Quinquennial inspections of the Almshouses and ensure utilities are effectively managed by the residents.
- Produce Monthly and Annual Accounts and liaise with the appropriate Auditor.
- Prepare and report on budgets in conjunction with the Trustees (Clerk to lead).
- Produce annual accounts and reports for the Trustees and Charity Commission.
- To provide oversight on periodic reviews of lease/tenancy renewals, fire, gas and legionella inspections, land valuations, rent reviews, investment reviews, charity policies
